Maccabi Multidisciplinary Telemedicine Centre for Chronic Disease Management

Session aim and description:

To present interactively the experience of Israel in the deployment of a 24/7 call centre of highly trained nurses supported by other professionals providing proactive care to patients with chronic diseases using computerized clinical care pathways and videoconferencing. The example will serve to present the work of the AA2 Group on Change Management and the B3 Maturity Model in a concrete practice. We will analyse the different stages and dimensions of the transformation process from the traditional services towards integrated care.

Maccabi recognizes the following challenges and barriers tackled by their system:

- Staff engagement: "Convincing the GP that this was support to him, not a threat"
- Recruiting and training nurses with the necessary knowledge and skills
- Financing
- Developing clinical care pathways to enable proactive care

These are some of the lessons learned that Maccabi is willing to share:

- Methods for working with GPs and facilitating GP/nurse teamwork
- Clinical pathways can be adapted to other systems
- The entire process from planning to large scale deployment can be at least replicated in other systems
- Right at the start: Call Phase I and not PILOT"
